Background

The Ministry of Health has a national project on Injuries Prevention, which is a part of the National Action Plan for the Prevention and Control of Non-communicable Diseases and Health promotion in Pakistan; this program is in collaboration with WHO and the NGO Heartfile. We are now in the stage of preparing a separate PC1 for the Injuries component of this program, and are exploring the option of developing partnerships and collaborating sites, which can take on the specific components of the program. For this purpose a consultation has been organized to deliberate on the strategy being proposed in the PC1.
