## Charter of Demand

We, the young SRHR leaders at Youth Ask Leadership Conclave 2014 organized by Youth Ask Alliance at Islamabad on  $9^{th} - 10^{th}$  August 2014 deliberated on our issues related to SRHR and have a consensus that WE WANT

- 1. Access to reliable, accurate and complete information on our health and rights
- 2. Access to safe, affordable and friendly health services for young people
- 3. To be at the **center** of all social and economic development **opportunities**.
- 4. To be free from **discrimination** on the basis of our age, gender and ethnicity.
- 5. To be included to take benefits of education and training
- 6. To be involved and have a say in all **processes that deter**mine and affect our present and future.
- 7. Our basic human rights to be recognized and respected and protected by everyone.
- 8. To feel safe and be free from physical, social and mental exploitation.
  - We, from the platform of Youth Ask Leadership Conclave urge the Federal Government of Pakistan and all the relevant line departments of the provincial Governments to
- 1. Ensure **meaningful youth participation** in all the federal and provincial policies that concerns young people and other decision-making forums including local Governments
- 2. Launch a national platform for the young people and youth-led organizations where they can discuss their issues and present recommendations directly to the decision-makers
- 3. Finalize the Provincial Youth Policies with meaningful youth engagement and ensure proper implementation where it exists
- 4. Include Life Skills in school curriculum for promoting healthy behaviours amongst young people
- 5. Initiate programs for awareness and sensitization of young people, their parents and other stakeholders at grassroots level on human rights, communicable diseases, especially Hepatitis and HIV & Aids, and existing laws of the Government
- 6. Ensure that Young people are provided with youth friendly health services
- 7. Ensure the Implementation of laws that protect human rights
- 8. Take necessary measures to end harmful traditional practices like honour killing, forced marriages, early / child marriages and exclusion on the basis of gender and sexual orientation
- 9. Provide protection to the victims of violence, sexual abuse, harassment and forced marriages
- 10. Ensure allocation of sufficient financial resources for health, education and population issues
